

## **Attention International Students**

In order to study in the U.S. international students are required to apply for a student visa at an U.S. embassy or consulate. Each student needs to present the following documents:

- Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student (Form I-20A-B)
- ➤ Online Nonimmigrant Visa Electronic Application (**Form DS-160**) complete prior to visa appointment (<a href="https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/">https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/</a>)
- Documentation of visa application fee payment
- ➤ A **passport** valid for at least six months beyond the date you will initially enter the United States
- ➤ One photograph, 2 x 2 inches (51 x 51 mm) for each applicant see your embassy website for detailed photo requirements
- ➤ The **SEVIS I-901 fee** receipt (<u>www.ice.gov/sevis/</u>)
- > Proof of admission to the U.S. university you plan to attend
- > Evidence of sufficient knowledge of English
- > Evidence of academic credentials qualifying you for admission
- > Evidence of sufficient financial support
- ➤ Evidence of sufficient ties to your home country
