Academic scholarships are awarded based on previous academic qualifications that are submitted by the student during the admission process. You are eligible for the scholarships listed below without SAT/ACT scores. Once enrolled at Webber, student academic scholarships will be locked in as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.

Full tuition Scholarship

Available to students who meet the unweighted GPA/TEST SCORE REQUIREMENT.
(Awarded to 2 students per year)

Honor's Scholarship- A \$1,000 a year scholarship available to high school graduates who have an unweighted 3.5 GPA, successfully completed college preparatory courses, are participating in extra curriculum and volunteer activities and honors societies. The student must be full time and maintain a minimum of a 3.4 GPA, earn a B or higher in their Business Honor courses and are active in the FBLA Collegiate Division.

Get-Involved! Leadership Scholarships

Talent & Leadership- This scholarship is \$1,000 per year and may be in addition to the academic scholarships above. You are able to qualify for this scholarship through previous participation in high school or college organizations such as student government, publications, and PBL. This scholarship requires the student to participate in a certain number of hours per week, in a club or organization, that has positions available. Please contact your admissions counselor for the application.

Campus Service Scholarship- This scholarship is for non-athletes and is \$6,000 per year and may be combined with our Academic scholarships. The student is required to participate in a certain number of hours per week, to participate in a club or organization, that has positions available.

Polk County Hometown Scholarship- Available to Polk County High school students, and is up to 40% of tuition. The student must submit a 500-word essay outlying why this is a good fit for them along with a letter of recommendation from their guidance counselor.

Jessica Costanzo Scholarship- Available to one incoming freshman student, who graduated from Venice High-School per year, where Jessica graduated. This scholarship is \$1,000 per year. The student is required to fill out an application.

Kelly Wilson Scholarship- A one-time, \$1,000 scholarship available to a student who has overcome a hardship. The student must submit an essay of why they would be a great candidate and how they overcame an exceptional challenge.

Bachelors of Nursing Scholarship

Students can receive a \$12,000 Nursing Scholarship that meet specific criteria.

- Must have a 2.75 unweighted GPA
- Must be a non-athlete
- Not stackable with merit-based scholarships
- Maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA and earn B's or better in core coursework for annual renewal

Bachelors of Occupational Therapy Assistant Scholarship

Students can receive a \$12,000 OTA Scholarship that meet specific criteria.

- Must have a 2.50 unweighted GPA
- Must be a non-athlete
- Not stackable with merit-based scholarships
- Maintain a 2.50 cumulative GPA and earn Cs or better in core coursework for annual renewal

Master of Arts in Education Scholarship

This scholarship is 40% off tuition for Educators and Educator Assistants wanting to pursue a Masters of Arts Education online. Students fill out the online application and provide documentation of current employment in the school system.

Polk County Sheriff Scholarship

This scholarship is available for students who are currently employed law enforcement with Polk County Sheriffs Office. The student is able to qualify for a discounted per credit hour rate. by providing proper employment verification.

Family Discount- Awarded to students and a family member that is enrolling while they are currently enrolled. Student should contact their financial aid advisor and will be applied to each enrolling family member. The scholarship is \$500 per student each year.

International Student Refer-A-Friend- A one-time scholarship awarded to international students who refer an international friend, but putting them on their application to enroll at the university. Student should contact their financial aid advisor and add the \$500 a year.

Alumni Scholarship- Awarded to students who have family members that have graduated from Webber. Student must provide proper documentation to their financial aid advisor in the enrollment process. This scholarship is 10% off tuition.

*All scholarships are quoted for a yearly amount. Students must be enrolled full time in the Webber traditional program to receive these scholarships.
